

Third and fourth session by Mr. Farhat Umar: Founder of Credo HR Solutions Ahmedabad.


The objective of the guest lecture was to make the students aware towards the civil services its scope and responsibility, through the subject expert.

In the last session of day 01 Prof. Nilesh Chhallare from IOM delivered a lecture on Manners and etiquettes in professional life.



Day 02: Scope of Pharmacy Education and Role of Parents, Teacher and students in Higher education




