Bhujbal Knowledge City, MET's Institute of Pharmacy, Adgaon, Nashik constituted International Student Cell in Academic Year 2015-2016.


Objectives:





This memorandum of understanding ("**MoU**") is executed on the 1st day of December, 2018 (the "**Effective date**"),

BETWEEN

ASAHI KASEI CORPORATION, 1-1-2 Yurakucho, Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo 100-0006 Japan through its senior GM of Functional Additives Division which expression shall unless repugnant to the context of meaning therefore include its successor and permitted assignees of the **FIRST PARTY**,

AND

MET's Institute of Pharmacy, Bhujbal Knowledge City, Adgaon, Nashik 422 003 (Maharashtra) established on 2006 and represented through its PRINCIPAL which expression shall include its successors in the office and permitted assignees of the **SECOND PARTY**,

And the First Party and the Second Party shall be collectively referred to as "**Parties**" and individually as "**Party**",

WITNESSETH:

Whereas the First Party having its objectives to introduce the High-Performance Microcrystalline Cellulose manufactured by the First Party ("**Excipient(s)**") to the faculty members and students of the Second Party.;

AND

Whereas the Second Party having its objectives to conduct the research work using the Excipient(s);

AND

Whereas, each Party will undertake to support each other's effort for the specific purpose mentioned in this MoU,

Now, Therefore, the Parties have intended, agreed and consented to the following terms and deeds in pursuance of the common intent:

1. The First Party:

- Shall provide the Excipient(s) sample to the faculty members and students of the Second Party;
- Shall provide the Second Party with technical advice relating to the Excipient(s), including but not limited to, formulation information of solid oral dosage forms using the Excipient(s).

2. The Second Party:

- Shall make all necessary infrastructural facilities such as instruments, equipment and laboratories available to conduct its own experiments using the Excipient(s).
- Shall conduct the comparative study of different grades of the Excipient(s), and other microcrystalline cellulose products and/or excipients available on market from different manufacturers.
- Shall use the statistical tools in the comparative study above.
- Shall publish the data through publication in pharmaceutical journal and/or academic conference.

3. This MoU will be effective when signed by both the parties and shall remain valid for three (3) years from the Effective date. The term of this MoU may be extended on a mutual written agreement.
4. Either Party shall have the right to terminate this MoU with thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other Party.
5. The obligations of each Party have been outlined in this MoU. Any alternations or modifications to this MoU shall be mutually discussed and agreed in writing.
6. In case Parties agree to conduct a collaborative research project, Parties shall negotiate and execute a new contract separately.
7. Parties shall maintain strict confidentiality of the information shared during the term of the MoU. None of the Parties shall disclose the information to anyone without prior written consent of the other Party.
8. Parties shall strive to settle any disputes amicably between themselves. Any and all disputes or controversies arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be submitted to and finally resolved by arbitration in Singapore in accordance with the Arbitration Rules of the Singapore International Arbitration Centre ("SIAC Rules") for the time being in force, which rules are deemed to be incorporated by reference in this clause. The Tribunal shall consist of three (3) arbitrator(s). The language of the arbitration shall be English.

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein above and the terms and conditions of this MoU and in witness whereof Parties have hereinto set their hand/seal:



THOUGHT AND PERSONNEL EXCHANGE**

This **Memorandum of Understanding** is executed on 3rd of September, 2018

BETWEEN

UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MARA (hereinafter referred to as “**UiTM**”), an institution of higher learning established under Universiti Teknologi MARA Act 1976 (Act 173) whose address is at the Chancellery, Universiti Teknologi MARA, 40450 Shah Alam, Selangor Malaysia and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns of the first part;

AND

MET’s Institute of Pharmacy, Nashik (hereinafter referred to as “**MET IOP**”), an institute of higher professional education affiliated to **Savitribai Phule Pune University (Formerly, University of Pune), Pune** whose address is at **Bhujbal Knowledge City, Adgaon, Nashik, Maharashtra, India-422003** and shall include its lawful representatives and permitted assigns of the other part;

(UiTM and MET IOP shall hereinafter be referred to singularly as “the Party” and collectively as “the Parties”)

WHEREAS

- A. UiTM is an established University with a track record of educational excellence and research and with a dynamic programme of collaborative arrangements with many international counterparts.
- B. MET IOP is a conglomerate of premiere educational institutions, driven by a single-minded focus on imparting quality education to make students academically, socially and technically sharp.
- C. The Parties agree that this Memorandum of Understanding is to be operationalized on behalf of UiTM by the Integrative Pharmacogenomics Institute, established by UiTM as a centre of excellence in conducting and translating cutting edge researches to achieve and enhance Precision Medicine whose address is at Level

7, FF3 Building, UiTM Selangor Branch, Puncak Alam Campus, 42300 Bandar Puncak Alam, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

- D. The Parties are desirous of entering this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a basis of cooperation and collaboration between the Parties upon the terms as contained herein.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1: OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, shall endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop research, development and commercialization co-operation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

ARTICLE 2: AREAS OF CO-OPERATION

- 2.1 Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular, to promote academic-industry co-operation in the following areas:
- a) PhD and postdoctoral studies;
 - b) Research grant application and collaborative research work;
 - c) Organisation of symposia, conferences, short courses and meetings on research, development and commercialization issues;
 - d) Exchange of information pertaining to student development, research innovation and commercialisation; and
 - e) Co-operation in any other areas as agreed to by the Parties from time to time.

- 2.2 For the purpose of implementing the co-operation in respect of any areas stated in paragraph 2.1 the Parties shall enter into legally binding agreements subject to terms and conditions as mutually agreed upon by the parties including clauses on “confidentiality”, “suspension”, “protection of intellectual property rights” and “settlement of disputes”.

ARTICLE 3: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

- 3.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other unless otherwise stated.
- 3.2 Each Party shall bear its own cost and expenses in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE 4: EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and shall not give rise to any legal process and shall not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, expressed or implied.

ARTICLE 5: NO AGENCY

Nothing contained herein is to be construed so as to constitute a joint venture partnership or formal business organisation of any kind between the Parties or so to constitute either party as the agent of the other.

ARTICLE 6: ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

- 6.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective as of the date of signatures of both parties, or if the dates vary, then the date of the later signature.
- 6.2 This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in effect for a period of FIVE (5) years.
- 6.3 This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for such further period as may be agreed in writing by both parties.
- 6.4 If the Memorandum of Understanding is not renewed by mutual consent, the Memorandum Understanding shall conclude at the end of the specified period, or after activities in progress have concluded.

ARTICLE 7: REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

- 7.1 Either party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 7.2 Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 7.3 Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.
- 7.4 Any revision, variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this Memorandum of Understanding before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

ARTICLE 8: TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party with a minimum of THIRTY (30) days written notice. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.

ARTICLE 9: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this MoU will first be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the Parties.

ARTICLE 10: NOTICES

Any communication under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be in writing in the English language and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of Universiti Teknologi MARA or MET IOP, as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic, mail address or facsimile number as either Party may have notified the other Party and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or facsimile number which is duly acknowledged:





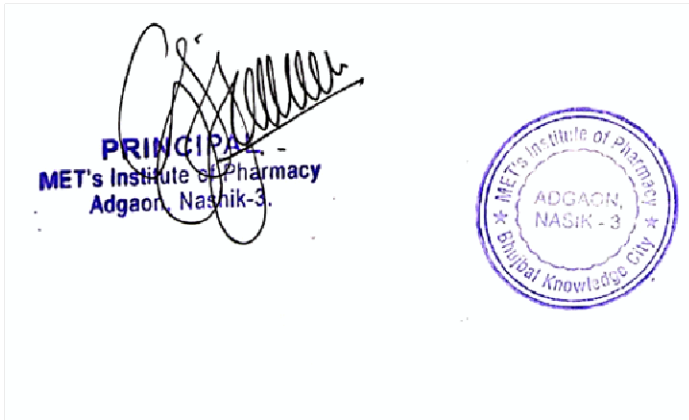
